

PICTURE WHAT THE LORD HAS DONE POSTER CONTEST



Theme: Picture What the Lord Has Done since 1492 when Columbus arrived at America. (The theme is inspired by the lyrics of a song by Karen Wheaton).

Who Can Enter: Students living in Kentucky

Three Grade Divisions:

1. Kindergarten through Third Grade
2. Fourth through Sixth Grade
3. Seventh through Twelfth Grade

Prizes: Each division will have three winners. First place winners will receive \$100. Second place winners will receive \$50. Third place winners will receive \$25. The winners will be announced on October 1, 2022 at 5PM. Winners do not have to be in attendance to win.

Deadline: Posters must be received at 616 Clintonville Rd., Paris, KY 40361 by mail or in person no later than October 1, 2022 at noon.

Rules:

- Posters should depict events, people, or places (anywhere in the world) that were important in the history of Christianity since the discovery of America in 1492.
- Artwork must be original by each student. (Exceptions will be granted for special needs students who have received assistance when this is noted on the entry form.)
- Only one submission from each student will be accepted.
- The minimum size of the poster is 8 ½ x 11 inches; the maximum size is 11 x 17 inches.
- Posters should be created using LANDSCAPE orientation.
- All supplies, including the poster and the materials must be supplied by the student.
- Accepted materials are: colored pencils, pens, charcoal, pastels, chalk, crayons, paints, markers, and mixed media. No digital tools should be used to create the poster. No organic material such as beans, rice, or macaroni is acceptable. Mounted or framed posters will not be accepted.
- No identifying information should be on the front of the poster. A completed entry form should be attached to the back of the poster.
- Upon entry, the poster and an image of the poster will become available for use online, in social and print media by the Kentucky Faith & Public History Education Project. The title of the poster along with the first name and city of the artist may be displayed along with the image.
- Following the award ceremony, the posters will be available for the artists to pick up. Posters will not be mailed back to the contestants. However, they will be retained at 616 Clintonville Rd., Paris KY 40361 until December 31, 2022.
